Dear Tim

Several years ago I purchased some RENSHADE to put under the roof of a west facing translucent laserlite roof on a deck. This product worked very well and certainly reduced the heat under the roof. The problem was that the 1350mm aluminium coated paper was a bit flimsy and although stapled onto the beams and the sheets joined with clear packing tape and battened at the edges, the tape eventually gave way due to wind and the amount of heat locked in between the roof and the RENSHADE.

I contacted you again several weeks ago and found that you had changed the formulation of the RENSHADE and had made it of a far more robust material and 1250mm wide. I decided to try this and to my surprise it was much easier to install and when I had finished, it was a professional job and far superior to what I had originally installed. I was so impressed that I decided to replace the RENSHADE on the other panels roof.

I found that putting battens at the joins of the RENSHADE and using double sided tape along some of the beams made the installation very quick and easy. After completion the beams and battens were stapled regularly then covered with "D" strips creating a very tight and neat finish that will not succumb to the elements.

Many thanks for producing such a good product.
